Impression

IMPRESSION:

Large heterogeneous mass abutting right lobe of liver and gallbladder appears to have vascular flow and is most consistent with a solid mass. Recommend 3 phase liver CT at this time to better evaluate.

Gallbladder filled with stones. No sonographic findings to suggest cholecystitis.

Narrative

CLINICAL INDICATION: RUQ Pain

COMPARISON: CT 5/12/2007

TECHNIQUE: Sonographic evaluation of the right upper quadrant was performed using grayscale ultrasound and color Doppler imaging.

FINDINGS:

LIVER:

Size: 17.5 cm

Findings: Solid heterogeneous appearing mass measuring 9.7 x 7.5 x 8.7 cm is contiguous with the right lobe of the liver and gallbladder demonstrates vascular flow.

Main Portal Vein: 1.2 cm phasic flow, hepatopetal flow

GALLBLADDER:

Findings: Gallbladder is filled with stones, no wall thickening, Negative sonographic Murphy sign

CBD measurement: 4 mm

PANCREAS:

Findings: Portions of the pancreas are obscured by gas. Visualized portions are within normal limits.

RIGHT KIDNEY:

Size: 9.9 cm

Findings: Unremarkable

AORTA: Visualized portions show no aneurysmal dilatation.

IVC: Visualized proximal portion is unremarkable.
